

Dear author(s)

The Programme Chairs for the 29th Conference of the Foundation for Endangered Languages are delighted to tell you that your abstract has been accepted for presentation at the conference, to be held in Vitoria-Gasteiz, Basque Country, Spain, 22-24(+25) October 2025. Your abstract was reviewed by the FEL 2025 Programme Committee and by the Programme Chairs.

You are now requested to update and extend your abstract, following the suggestions by the reviewers (at the bottom of your notification letter). **The submission deadline is Monday 1 September 23:59 GMT.** Please find below details about format, size and submission of your abstract and about further steps to be taken.

Next steps with respect to your abstract:

1. Please **confirm your intention to present** your abstract at FEL XXIX 2025 **by Friday 11 July** by email to the following two addresses: felxxix2025@easychair.org (Chairs) and fel2025@ehu.es (Organisers). Apart from your confirmation and the abstract number (see Notification message), your email should state the name of the person who will present the abstract, and whether this person will present it in person in Vitoria-Gasteiz or on-line.
2. **Update and extend** your abstract, taking into account the suggestions by the reviewers (see bottom of the notification letter) and the suggestions by the Programme Committee below. Please note that reviewers may not always be unanimous.
3. **Indicative size of the extended abstract is 2000-3000 words** (ca 4-6 pages, including data, graphics and references), in English.
4. **Format your abstract according to the FEL style sheet** (also attached to your notification letter, and also downloadable from <https://www.ogmios.org/conferences/2025/>), and convert it to PDF. The FEL 2025 paper size is A4. Please note that you can NOT use your original abstract, as it does not comply with the style and size requirements for your updated abstract.
5. **Connect to EasyChair** at <https://easychair.org/conferences/?conf=felxxix2025>
6. **Check whether the title and the authors** as listed on EasyChair are still correct, as these will be used in indexes and table of contents (please avoid academic and other titles in names of authors, just forenames and family names will do). Use capitals in the title of your abstract as prescribed in the style sheet.
7. **Submit your PDF abstract to EasyChair as an update** of your original submission, **by Monday 1 September 23:59 GMT** at the very latest. Abstracts for which no update in the proper FEL format have been received by then will be considered as withdrawn and cannot be presented at the conference.

Next steps with respect to your participation in the conference:

1. Please inform the local organisers **by 1 September** at the latest **if there have been any changes** in the person presenting or presentation modality (in person or on-line). Email address: fel2025@ehu.es

2. **If you plan to present in person** you have to send your presentation (in PowerPoint or PDF) to the local organisers by 15 October at the latest. Email address: fel2025@ehu.es . The duration of your presentation will be 20 minutes, followed by 10 minutes for questions from the audience and your answers. Please make sure that the number of slides matches the time allocated to your presentation. All PowerPoints and PDFs will be uploaded to the central PC in the auditorium, and shown from there.
3. **On-line presentation is ONLY possible via a pre-recorded video** to be sent to the local organisers at fel2025@ehu.es by 15 October. The duration of your pre-recorded video presentation will be 20 minutes, during the session followed by 10 minutes for questions from in person and on-line participants, and for your answers live via Teams. Live on-line presentation is not possible.
4. **All presenters will have to join FEL and register for the conference.** For presenters the **registration deadline is 1 September 23:59 GMT**. Here are some additional suggestions by the Programme Committee for preparing your updated abstract (apart from the first one they may not all be equally applicable, but you can use them as a checklist):

- Please explain how your presentation makes the connection between Endangered Languages and Sustainable Development (this is obligatory).
- Please include information about the geographic location of the language community.
- Tell us the source of the data being used (data on the language itself and data on the language situation and data on the evaluation of the methods used for language revitalisation etc).
- Tell us about any theoretical frameworks or models you have used for your study.
- Tell us about how this work builds on previous language/linguistic work for this particular community and language.
- Tell us what is new in this presentation - whether it is a new project or an update on an ongoing project.
- Give a little background on the researchers: e.g., academic or community language workers, or a combination of both.
- Include basic references about the language you are writing about.
- If your native language is not English we recommend that you ask someone who is proficient in English to have a look at your text before submitting it.
